Final Announcement

The annual Paleoanthropology Society meeting will be held in Austin Texas on Tuesday and Wednesday April 10 and 11 in conjunction with the American Association of Physical Anthropologists. The conference hotel is the Hyatt Regency Austin (208 Barton Springs, Austin Texas 78704). Additional useful hotel information can be obtained from the AAPA web site (<http://physant.org>). On Tuesday the meeting will convene in the "Texas 1" room. On Wednesday the meeting room will be "Zilker 4."

Conference registration will take place Tuesday morning at the entrance to Texas 1 starting at 7:30 AM. The meeting will begin promptly at 9:00.

NOTE: Because the Society for American Archaeology annual meeting begins on Thursday April 12 and many participants may wish to attend it, the Paleoanthropology annual business meeting will be held during the luncheon break on Wednesday. This will facilitate late Wednesday departures to the SAA meeting.

Presentation Information

Oral presentations will be strictly limited to 15 minutes, and a power point projector and computer will be provided. Participants should arrive before the start of their session to load their presentations.

The poster session will begin at approximately 4:00 in the "Texas Foyer" on Tuesday and presenters should set up their material on Tuesday before that time. Spaces may be selected by the participants and will not be assigned. Mounting supplies are not provided and presenters should bring their own pushpins or double-sided tape. Electricity will not be available. The poster display area is 42" x 42." Once again, the Society wishes to have pdf copies of all posters after the meeting to place on our website (they will be cross-linked to the NESPOS website).
