- Job Summary: CENIEH is seeking a Research Fellow in Cognitive Archaeology for applying to the current Marie Skłodowska Curie Actions-Individual Fellowships call (HORIZON-MSCA-2023-PF-01) which closes on 13 September 2023
- Job Description: The Fellow with the successful proposal will join a team of researchers in the Archaeology Program at CENIEH. The main research focus of the program is field and laboratory investigations on the origin and evolution of lithic technology during the Pleistocene. The candidate will be involved in field and laboratory investigations with international scientists working at Gona (Afar, Ethiopia) and Ain Hanech (Algeria), to study lithic technological changes through time, particularly for understanding hominin behaviour and cognition. The major role of the candidate should involve lithic technological studies by describing and replicating stone tool assemblages, and by employing cognitive methods for understanding the different stages in the evolution of stone tool technologies seen in human behavioural evolution during the Pleistocene. The candidate will develop his investigations in collaboration with colleagues in the Archaeology Program in the newly established state of the art laboratory of experimental Archaeology and Taphonomy at CENIEH.

### **Additional Requirements**

- **Specific Requirements:** Archaeological fieldwork experience is required, and knowledge of raw material petrography is preferred. Also, knowledge of experimental knapping is expected for investigating stone flaking properties and technological evolution through time.
- Specific Requirements: The conditions of the MSCA-2023-PF-01 call apply.

There are 2 types of Postdoctoral Fellowships:

- <u>European Postdoctoral Fellowships.</u> They are open to researchers moving within Europe or coming to Europe from another part of the world to pursue their research career. These fellowships take place in an EU Member State or Horizon Europe Associated Country and can last between 1 and 2 years. Researchers of any nationality can apply.
- <u>Global Postdoctoral Fellowships</u>. They fund the mobility of researchers outside Europe. The fellowship lasts between 2 to 3 years, of which the first 1 to 2 years will be spent in a non-associated Third Country, followed by a mandatory return phase of 1 year to an organisation based in an EU



Member State or Horizon Europe Associated Country. Only nationals or long-term residents of the EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries can apply.

For both, the most relevant requirements are:

- ✓ The researcher must be in possession of a doctoral degree and have a maximum of eight years' experience\* in research.
- ✓ The researcher should comply with mobility rules: they must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the beneficiary (for European Postdoctoral Fellowships), or the host organisation for the outgoing phase (for Global Postdoctoral Fellowships) for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before the call deadline

\*The limit of 8-years full-time research experience is determined based on the date of award of the (first) PhD and the call deadline.
